

Cancer common treatment costs

AIA Cancer Care covers you for a range of procedures that help you manage unexpected medical bills.

Mastectomy (Unilateral): **\$17,000 - \$30,000**

Mastectomy with breast reconstruction: **\$50,000 - \$100,000**

Removal of skin lesion: **\$500 - \$10,000**

Bowel resection: **\$40,000 - \$60,000**

Robotic prostatectomy: **\$32,000 - \$35,000**



Additional diagnosis and treatment costs you and your family could experience:
