
# These are costs you could expect to pay if you're treated in a private hospital without health insurance



### Here are some common treatments you or your family could experience

#### **Cancer treatments**

Removal of cancerous skin lesions \$1,000 - \$9,500 Chemotherapy \$15,000 - \$170,000 (Per treatment cycle)

Radiotherapy **\$20,000 - \$55,000** (Per treatment cycle)

#### **Diagnostics**

PET Scan \$2,000 - \$3,200 MRI Scan \$1,500 - \$3,000 CT Scan \$1,300 - \$1,700 Ultrasound \$500 - \$1,500

#### Children 0-20 years

Grommets \$2,200 - \$3,500
(Insertion of tubes in the eardrums)
Adenotonsillectomy \$4,000 - \$5,500
(Surgical removal of adenoids and tonsils)
